

Preschool Shyness Study Progress



After four years of working with families, we have had 151 families participate in the study. We have also visited the many different preschools that the children attended to see how they play in their classrooms, allowing us to see how the program may have made a difference for the children and their parents. Over the next year, we will continue to follow up with families to see how children and parents are doing a year after they participate in the groups. We are excited to begin looking at the outcomes of the two treatments we tested!

- Have a fall family picnic





Principal Investigator Update



Kenneth Rubin is a Professor of Human Development and Director of the Center for Children, Relationships, and Culture at the U. Maryland College Park. During the past academic year, Dr. Rubin published two Handbooks in the area of Child Development.

Dr. Rubin is beginning a new study examining how 3-5-year old preschool children's play behaviors change over time.

Lab Manager Spotlight


